

Hello Friends! This is your Trinity COVID-19 Update for December 10, 2021.

We completed our routine testing at Trinity Assisted Living yesterday and are excited to announce that all elders and employees have tested negative for COVID-19. We have three elders remaining in isolation who are well and are scheduled to be out early next week. This is a gift from God for our facility! We have planned our Resident's Christmas Dinner for December 15th, and everyone will be able to attend.

We continue to follow all recommendations provided by CMS and the Mississippi State Department of Health. Please note that the MSDH defines an outbreak in long-term care facilities as a single positive case among elders or employees.

The two elders from the Apartments at Trinity Place who were diagnosed with COVID-19 last week are doing well and are receiving appropriate care.

Trinity Healthcare remains COVID-19 free and is open to regular visits and activities.
