

Hello Friends! This is your Trinity Campus COVID-19 Update for August 16, 2021.

At Trinity Healthcare Center, we have one elder who has been diagnosed with COVID-19. The elder is quarantined and receiving appropriate care. All elders and other employees have been tested and are negative at this time. Unfortunately, this means a continued halt to visits, group activities and communal dining. Group testing will be conducted again on Thursday, August 19, and a plan for resuming our normal routines will be developed after that testing. Testing will continue every 3-7 days until we are 14 days with no positive results.

We continue to follow all guidance set forth by state and federal officials for privacy, elder care, employee safety, and efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19. We closely adhere to the routine testing policy for elders and employees as laid out by CMS and the MSDH.

Trinity Assisted Living continues with no reported cases of COVID-19.

The Apartments at Trinity Place had an employee who tested positive for COVID-19 today. MSS defines an outbreak in the Apartments as three or more cases in a 14-day time frame. For now visiting, activities and dining remain open as they have been.

Mississippi continues with increases in cases being reported. The CDC news is encouraging for those who are vaccinated. Many locations locally are offering the vaccine to anyone age 12 and over. If you have not yet received yours, please consider doing so. Lowndes County has a positivity rate of 24.7 % which is among the highest in the state. It is recommended that all wear a mask in areas of heightened transmission. Please be safe and help us to stay safe as well; wear a mask.
