

Hello Friends! This is your Trinity Campus COVID-19 Update for August 20, 2021.

At Trinity Assisted Living, we have two elders who have been diagnosed with COVID-19. The elders are quarantined and receiving appropriate care. All elders and employees have been tested and are negative at this time. The cases affected an elder on each hall, this means we will have to halt visits, group activities and communal dining for at least 14 days. If you need to visit, window visits can be arranged. Group testing will continue every 3-7 days until we are 14 days with no positive results.

We continue to follow all guidance set forth by state and federal officials for privacy, elder care, employee safety, and efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19.

Mississippi continues with increases in cases being reported. The most recent CDC news is encouraging for those who are fully vaccinated. Many locations locally are offering the vaccine to anyone age 12 and over. If you have not yet received yours, please consider doing so. Lowndes County has a positivity rate of 24.7 % which is among the highest in the state. It is recommended that all wear a mask in areas of heightened transmission. Please be safe and help us to stay safe as well; wear a mask.
