

Hello Friends! This is your Dugan COVID-19 Update for January 6, 2022

We have been notified that two elders and five employees from Dugan have been diagnosed with COVID-19. Everyone is quarantined and is receiving appropriate care. We continue to follow the CDC's criteria for return to work for all employees.

As of today, we have a total of 3 elders and 17 employees who have tested positive for COVID-19 over the past few days. All had been vaccinated and are either asymptomatic or only exhibiting mild symptoms. All other elders and employees have tested negative for the virus.

We have notified public health officials and are following all recommendations provided by CMS and the Mississippi State Department of Health. Please note that the MSDH defines an outbreak in long-term care facilities as a single positive case among elders or employees. We closely adhere to the routine testing policy for elders and employees as laid out by CMS and the MSDH.

Mississippi is currently seeing a very large spike in COVID-19 cases. We cannot emphasize enough how important it is for everyone to continue to take all measures possible to slow the spread of the virus. Please practice social distancing, wear a mask, perform good hand sanitation and whenever possible, avoid being out in the general public.

Vaccination remains the most effective way to prevent severe illness, hospitalization, and death from COVID-19. Everyone aged 5 and older should be fully vaccinated, and those 18 and over should receive a booster at the appropriate time. While we are currently open to indoor visits, it is critical that everyone take every measure possible to protect the elders and our team members.
