

Hello Friends! This is your Flowers Manor COVID-19 Update for August 17, 2021.

It has been one week since any one on Flowers Manor campus was diagnosed with COVID-19.

All elders who live in the Green House and all employees of Flowers Manor were negative in yesterday's group testing. We will resume communal dining, group activities, and visits at this time. We do encourage you to visit outdoors as it is safest. We will continue testing every 3-7 days until we are 14 days from the positive test.

This week, Coahoma County is in the red category for positivity. We are considered an area of high transmission. Elders who are not fully vaccinated are now asked to quarantine in their apartment for seven days if they choose to leave the campus for any reason (family get togethers, church, beauty shop, grocery store, etc.).

Mississippi is currently seeing positive cases rise rapidly from day to day. The most recent news from the CDC shows that those who are vaccinated fair much better against COVID-19 than those who are not. The vaccine is available locally to all over the age of 12. If you have not received a vaccination, please consider doing so at this time. Regardless of your vaccination status, you should wear a mask when in areas of heightened transmission.
