

Hello Friends! This is your Traceway COVID-19 Update for January 12, 2022

We have been notified that five elders and two employees have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

We currently have a total of 53 active COVID-19 cases including 24 elders and 29 employees.

Cedars/Green Houses: 13 Elders and 25 Employees

The Mitchell Center: 7 Elders and 2 Employees

The Manor/Villas: 4 Elders

Therapy: 2 Employees

Most everyone is either asymptomatic or only exhibiting mild symptoms. All positive individuals are quarantined and are receiving appropriate care. We continue to follow the CDC's criteria for return to work for all employees.

We have notified public health officials and are following all recommendations provided by CMS and the Mississippi State Department of Health. Please note that the MSDH defines an outbreak in long-term care facilities as a single positive case among elders or employees. We closely adhere to the routine testing policy for elders and employees as laid out by CMS and the MSDH.

We believe this is a special community, and that has been evident through the ways in which we have persevered for nearly two years in navigating this pandemic. We understand there is a lot of COVID fatigue out there, but our best path forward is to follow the established protocols and limit the spread as much as possible. Ultimately, vaccination remains the best and most widely available protection against severe illness, hospitalization or death from COVID-19. We strongly encourage everyone to get vaccinated and boosted.

Traceway is currently open to indoor visits, but it is important that you understand your risks before visiting. Lee County currently has a 50.59% positivity rate for the virus. Visiting Traceway during an active outbreak places visitors at an increased risk of contracting the virus, as well as potentially passing the virus on to the elders and team members. Please consider this as you make plans to visit our campus.
