

Hello Friends! This is your Traceway COVID-19 Update for December 25, 2021.

We have been notified that an elder from the Apartments at Traceway Manor has been diagnosed with COVID-19. The elder is quarantined and is receiving appropriate care.

We continue to follow all recommendations provided by CMS and the Mississippi State Department of Health. Please note that the MSDH defines an outbreak in long-term care facilities as a single positive case among elders or employees. We closely adhere to the routine testing policy for elders and employees as laid out by CMS and the MSDH.

While we are currently open to indoor visits across the campus, it is critical that everyone take all precautions to eliminate the risk of spreading any type of virus to the elders and our team members. The safest protection against COVID-19 is to be fully vaccinated. If you have not taken the vaccine, please consider it at this time. In addition, it is recommended that all wear a mask regardless of their vaccination status. This is especially important as our State's COVID-19 cases are beginning to rise and new variants are emerging. As we gather in celebration of Christmas, let us all take every measure possible to protect those we love.
