

Hello Friends! This is your Traceway COVID-19 Update for December 10, 2020.

Our team has completed our COVID-19 testing at Traceway Manor, and we'd like to share those results with you.

We had one elder test positive for COVID-19. All other elders and employees have tested negative for the virus. The elder is quarantined and is receiving appropriate care. We have notified public health officials and are following all recommendations provided by the CDC and the Mississippi State Department of Health. This brings the Manor count to nine active cases of COVID-19.

The Manor will remain on quarantine until we are clear of infection. We are asking all elders to remain in their apartments to ensure the virus is not spread within the Manor. All in-person dining will remain closed, and we will continue delivering meals to each room. In addition, our team will also make mail delivery for each elder as well. All internal group gatherings and activities will be put on hold until we are out of this quarantine period. In addition, we are restricting family visitation at this time.

Mississippi is currently seeing very large numbers of infections diagnosed each day and we must remain vigilant in order to prevent further infection at Traceway. Lee County is currently a red county with a positivity rate of 18.5% which is among the highest across the state. We ask that all elders continue to shelter in place as much as possible. Please let our employees, your family and our volunteers help keep you safe by running errands and allowing you to stay protected.

In addition, we want to ask everyone to take every measure possible to slow the spread of the virus. Please continue to practice social distancing, wear a mask, perform good hand sanitation, refrain from group gatherings of any size and whenever possible, avoid being out in the general public. Please do your part to keep Traceway's elders and employees safe.
