

Hello Friends! This is your Wesley Manor COVID-19 Update for January 7, 2022.

We have been notified that one elder and one employee from Wesley Manor have been diagnosed with COVID-19. Both are quarantined and are receiving appropriate care. We continue to follow the CDC's criteria for return to work for all employees.

We continue to follow all guidance set forth by state and federal officials for privacy, elder care, employee safety, and efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19.

COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations are rising rapidly in the state as the Omicron variant spreads. As per recent guidance issued by the MSDH, masks should be worn indoors in public places to reduce the risk of transmission. Group gatherings and indoor activities can be major contributors of COVID-19 transmission. Please keep these gatherings few and small.

Vaccination remains the most effective way to prevent severe illness, hospitalization, and death from COVID-19. Everyone aged 5 and older should be fully vaccinated, and those 18 and over should receive a booster at the appropriate time.

While we are currently open to indoor visits, it is critical that everyone take every measure possible to protect the elders and our team members.
