

Hello Friends! This is your Wesley Manor COVID-19 Update for July 6, 2021.

We have been notified that an elder from Wesley Manor has been diagnosed with COVID-19. All elders, their loved ones and employees who may have been exposed have been notified of the situation. The elder is quarantined and receiving appropriate care.

We continue to follow all guidance set forth by state and federal officials for privacy, elder care, employee safety, and efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19. Please note that the MSS defines an outbreak in Apartment Living as three positive cases among elders or employees over a 14-day period.

At this time, Wesley Manor remains open for visits, dining and activities as it has been. We do encourage use of masks in common areas especially for any elders who have not received the vaccine.
