Dear Elders, Families and Friends of MSS,

Today, we were notified that an employee from Wesley Meadows has tested positive for COVID-19. The employee is quarantined at home and is receiving appropriate care. We continue to follow the CDC's criteria for return to work for all employees. We have notified public health officials and are following all recommendations provided by CMS and the Mississippi State Department of Health.

We are currently contacting anyone who may have interacted with this employee to make them aware of the situation. We continue to follow all guidance set forth by state and federal officials for privacy, elder care, employee safety, and efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19. Please note that the MSDH defines an outbreak in long-term care facilities as a single positive case among elders or more than one case among employees over a 14-day period.

Mississippi's numbers are currently very high, so we want to remind everyone to take every measure possible to slow the spread of this virus. Please continue to practice social distancing, wear a mask, perform good hand sanitation, keep the size of your group gatherings small and whenever possible, avoid being out in the general public. Please do your part to ensure everyone stays virus-free as we head into the holiday season.
